

How to reach Soraga, in Val di Fassa

How to reach us by car on the A22 (Modena- Brennero)

Exit at Ora/Egna

The Ora/Egna exit is 45 km from Soraga.

Follow directions for:

- S.S. 48 delle Dolomiti
- Passo San Lugano
- Val di Fiemme
- Val di Fassa

At the Moena ring road (Industrial Area) follow directions for Soraga.

Exit Bolzano nord

The Bolzano nord exit is 40 km from Soraga.

Follow directions for:

- S.S. 241 Grande Strade delle Dolomiti
- Passo Carezza
- Vigo di Fassa
- Soraga

How to reach us by car on the A27

Exit Belluno/Ponte nelle Alpi

The exit Belluno/Ponte nelle Alpi is 80 km from Soraga.

Follow directions for:

- S.S. 203 for Agordo
- S.P. 346 to the Passo San Pellegrino
- Moena
- Soraga



How to reach us by bus

The bus service linking Val di Fassa with Trento and Bolzano is very efficient, to the extent that a car becomes superfluous.

Public transport in the Valley is well organised and you can easily move from one village to another very comfortably and quickly.

You can buy bus tickets at the ticket offices or on board the bus.

From Soraga to Ciasa do Pare

Arriving from the north

Just before the town centre, you will see a Tamoil petrol station on your left.

Ignore the GPS if it tells you to turn right before the petrol station, that road is unpractical and unpaved.

After the petrol station, you come to some traffic lights and immediately afterwards you must turn right uphill along the Strada de Barbara. Take the first road on the right, before the church. Continue for a few more metres and you have arrived.

Arriving from the south

As soon as you pass the town centre, turn uphill to the left along the Strada de Barbara right after the traffic lights and the skibus stop on the right. Take the first road on your right before the church. Continue for another few metres and you have arrived.
